### **Joint Protest Rally to Demand Punishment for those Guilty of Demolition of Babri Masjid**

- **Let us unite against state organised communal violence and terror!**

In the current climate of systematic hate-mongering and communal conflict the occasion of 6 December becomes extremely relevant.

6 December 1992 and the communal violence that followed killing Muslims in Mumbai and other parts of the country, continues to haunt the country – not as a memory of the past, but as a painful reality that has been repeated over and over again – in Gujarat 2002, in Muzaffarnagar 2012, as well as in Trilokpuri and Bawana and other parts of Delhi in 2014, in the episodes of communal and sectarian violence in Odisha and Assam, in the continued denial of justice for the genocide of Sikhs in 1984.

Let us come together, irrespective of religion, language, caste, racial, regional and other differences and resolve to continue to fight till the guilty are punished. Let us fight for radical political reforms that will truly empower our people and build a modern and civilized India. Let us fight for legislation and mechanisms to prevent state-organised communal violence in future.
